Angela is in her fourth year as Head Coach of the Women 's Volleyball team at Southwestern. Angela's volley-

ball experience is extensive as both a player as well as a coach of men and women's volleyball. She is still one of the leading money winner's on the AVP tour (pro beach) and upon re-

tirement had 27 beach titles to her credit. Angela earned the Most Valuable Player award in 1988 while she was a member of the United States National Team and later that year went to the Seoul Olympics as an outside hitter. In 1996 she coached one the top U.S. medal hopefuls, Nancy Reno and Holly McPeak, at the Atlanta Olympics. Angela has held coaching positions at Cuyamaca College, Mesa College (men's volleyball), UC Santa Barbara, San Diego City College and University of Fairbanks, Alaska. A graduate of SDSU, Rock earned both All-American and Hall of Fame honors when she helped the team to two NCAA Final Four appearances.

Rock holds two Master's degrees—one from National University and the other from Azusa Pacific.
