PRESENTATION OF INITIAL COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PROPOSALS

Reference: Government Code Section 3547

Meetings between the Board and its designated representatives for the purpose of discussing the Board's position regarding any matter within the scope of representation shall be deemed closed meetings and held in Closed Session. All such discussion shall be deemed confidential. Except by majority authorization of the Governing Board, the content of such confidential discussions shall not be released to any party not present at the Closed Session, other than as required by the representatives in the performance of their negotiations duties.

The Superintendent/President is directed to enact administrative procedures that assure compliance with the requirements of Government Code Section 3547 regarding the presentation of initial proposals for collective bargaining to the Governing Board.
