

The 2014-2015 FAFSA application is available online at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>. Apply now to receive free grants from the Federal government to help pay your college expenses.

Apply for the Board of Governors Fee Waiver today. If you are eligible, your tuition will be paid for by the State of California. If you already paid your tuition and fees, and you qualify for the fee waiver, you must stop by the Student Services office to request your

refund.

Direct deposit is now available for financial aid grants, scholarships

and loans through Higher One. To get started, look for a bright green envelope in the mail. You must register your card infor-

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mation online to set up your profile. You may chose one of the

three options: activate the card, request direct deposit to your personal checking account or continue to receive a check in the mail.

Do you have a Student Education Plan (SEP)? Do you know what an SEP is? Do you know why an SEP is im-

portant?

If you answered "No" to any of these questions, it is very important that you understand what an SEP is and why it is important that you have one.

The SEP is developed between you and a counselor. It lists all of

the courses and other requirements you have to complete to achieve your academic goal. The SEP includes your educational goal (such as certificate, associate's degree, and/or transfer to a university), general education requirements, courses required by the major, graduation requirements, GPA minimum, electives and prerequisites, and any other requirements.

The SEP has all the directions to reaching your destination of graduation. Ultimately, college success means graduating. Having your degree will open the door to many satisfying career opportunities and facilitate achievement of personal goals. This success will allow you to live your desired lifestyle, which leads to happiness. It is amazing how something so simple (SEP) can lead to great things. So, make your appointment with a counselor to get your SEP.

NOTE: By the end of 2014 an SEP will be a requirement for all students!
