STUDENT EQUITY

Reference: Education Code Sections 66030, 66250 et seq., and 72010 et seq.;

Title 5 Section 54220

The College District shall have a Student Equity Plan. Following approval by the Governing Board, the plan shall be filed with the Chancellor's Office of the California Community Colleges.

The production of the Student Equity Plan should include:

- the active involvement of the constituent groups on campus through the Student Equity Planning Committee;
- involvement by representatives from the community who can articulate the perspectives and concerns of historically underrepresented groups; and
- campus-based research relating to student equity.

The Student Equity Plan shall address:

- institutional barriers to equity;
- goals for access, retention, degree and certificate completion, English as a Second Language and basic skills completion, and transfer for historically underrepresented groups;
- activities to attain the goals, including coordination of related programs;
- sources of funds for activities in the plan;
- a schedule and process for evaluation of progress toward the goals; and
- an executive summary that describes the groups for whom goals have been set, the goals, the initiatives that the district will use to achieve the goals, resources budgeted for that purpose, and the district officer or employee who can be contacted for further information.

The Student Equity Plan shall be developed, maintained, and updated under the supervision of the Vice President for Student Affairs.
