Why Apply to DSS?

DSS provides support to students with disabilities in obtaining services and accommodations.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for DSS:

You must be a Southwestern College student enrolled in at least one unit.

and

Complete a DSS Application to request services.

Have a disability that can be verified.

How to Apply?

DSS Applications are available at Southwestern College in Room S108...

or

you can download a DSS Application from: http://www.swccd.edu

Provide documentation to verify your disability or bring in the name and phone number of your health care practitioner.

Submit the application and disability verification in person at the DSS Office or by mail.
