 - physical exam/immunization forms filled out, immunization records and/or titers (lab work), social security card, driver’s license/state ID, and CPR certification.
- **Submit your CNA application packet in person or by U.S. Mail to:** Southwestern College Higher Education Center, Nursing & Health Occupation Programs, 8100 Gigantic Street, Room 4502, San Diego, CA 92154.
- Program & clinical requirement: communicate effectively in English language (comprehension, verbal and writing skills).
- No prerequisite courses needed to apply.
