

An evacuation will be ordered after a natural or man-made emergency or disaster. The evacuation may be District-wide, campus-wide or building/location specific. The goal of an evacuation is to separate students, faculty, and staff members from harm in an orderly and expeditious manner.


Persons who are ordered to evacuate should comply with communicated instructions or directions from staff members and follow these guidelines:

- Be familiar with building exits beforehand.
- · When the evacuation is ordered, move in a calm and deliberate way to the nearest exit.
- \cdot Be mindful of events that could interfere with an evacuation, such as blocked stairways due to fire or smoke.
- · Do not delay by gathering possessions or other items.
- · Exit the building and proceed to the nearest evacuation zone.
- · Assist others who may be injured or disabled.
- · Stand by as staff members will be seeking to account for all persons


