

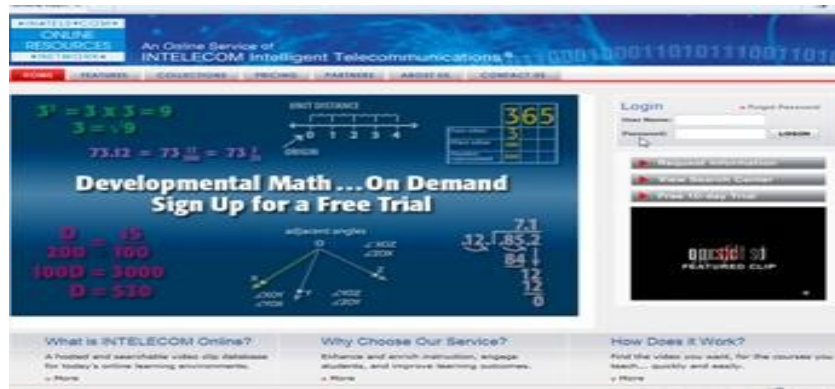

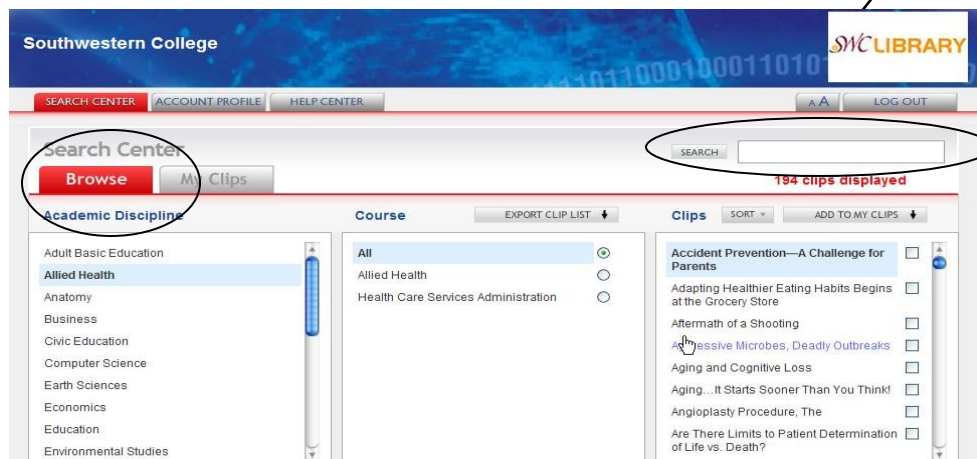

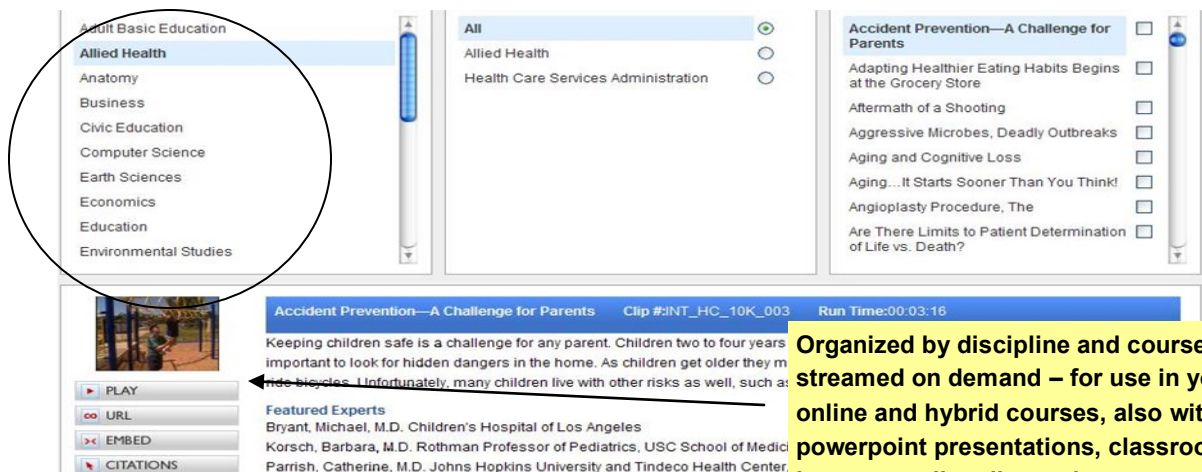
Step 1: Visit <http://searchcenter.intelecomonline.net/SearchCenter.aspx>




Step 2: Once your account is authenticated you will automatically be directed to the Search Center.




