Applicants may be majoring in any of the following:

- Chemistry/Biochemistry
- Geography
- Geology
- Math/Computer Science
- Engineering
- **Physics**

Other Eligibility Criteria:

- Completed some college level Math and Physics (Math 250 and Physics 270 preferred)
- Plans to transfer to a fouryear institution from SWC (does not need to have applied yet)
- 3.0 or above GPA preferred
- **U.S. Citizenship required** (Not eligible if you claim dual citizenship)
