

# Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) to CSU

An **Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)** provides a clear pathway for students to transfer to the California State University (CSU) system after completing a minimum of 60 transferable units, which include a specific set of major and general education courses at Southwestern College (SWC).

Students who earn an ADT are **guaranteed admission** to the CSU system, though **not necessarily to a specific campus or major**. To fully understand the requirements, benefits, and best fit for your academic goals, it is highly recommended that you meet with an SWC Counselor.

### Requirements for all ADT Degrees:

- ☐ Completion of minimum 60 semester or 90 quarter units of transferable degree applicable courses
- ☐ Completion of minimum overall grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in all transferable coursework, including a minimum "C" grade (or "Pass") required in each course for Cal-GETC.
- ☐ Completion of a Minimum 18 semester or 27 quarter units in major or area of emphasis with a minimum grade of "C" (or "Pass") for each course in the major
- ☐ Completion of the [California General Education Transfer Curriculum \(Cal-GETC\) pattern](#). For more information, see "[Certificate of Achievement](#)" under Graduation, Certificates, and Degree Requirements
- ☐ Students must apply to the CSU during the application filing period
- ☐ Students **MUST petition** with the SWC Evaluation Office for the ADT degree (see [SWC website for graduation petition process and deadlines](#).)
- ☐ **Electronic Verification** of ADT to the CSU's are only provided after students apply for SWC Graduation.
